### **Alto Almanzora Este 2007 Valle de Almanzora, Spain 18**

*a deep purple blend that has smoke, spice and wild blueberries*

### **La Puerta Cabernet Sauvignon 2008 Famatina Valley, Argentina 19**

*expansive flavors of plums, dark berries, black tea, smoky currant and vibrant acidity*

### **Alamos Malbec 2008 Mendoza Argentina 22**

*aromas of plums, white pepper and cloves with layers of raspberries, oak and leather*

### **Ercavio Tempranillo 2007 La Mancha, Spain 23**

*thick, dense and opulent on the palate with gobs of savory black fruit, licorice and spice*

### **Louis Jadot Beaujollais Villages 2008 France 24**

*balanced food friendly wine with ripe fruit and light tannins*

### **2 Up Shiraz 2007 South Australia 25**

*bright aromas and flavors of spicy blueberry and plum with a subtle hint of chocolate and beautifully integrated oak*

### **High Note "Elevated" Malbec 2008, Mendoza Argentina 25**

*brilliant violet color accompanied by aromas and flavors of rich blueberry and black cherry*

### **Jean-Luc Colombo "Les Abeiles" Rouge 2006**

#### **Cotes du Rhone, France 26**

*medium bodied, slightly tannic red with notes of saddle leather, currants and pepper*

### **St. Cosme Little James Basket Press Rouge, France 26**

*grenche based wine showing ripe strawberry with hints of violet, almond and oriental spices*

### **Chateau du Montepizat Merlot 2008, France 27**

*full bodied wine with red berries; it has a long finish with smooth tannins*

### **Crios de Susana Balbo Syrah/Bonarda 2007 Mendoza, Argentina 27**

*bright and juicy with black currants, cherries and licorice flavors backed by spice and floral notes on the racy finish*

### **Kilikanoon "The Lackey" Shiraz 2006, South Australia 28**

*aromas of cedar, bacon, plums and blueberries that lead to a medium bodied wine with good grip, intensity and length*

### **Thorn Clark Cabernet Sauvignon 2007 Barossa Valley, Australia 28**

*offers a mouthful of bright raspberry, white chocolate, rhubarb and spice that mingle and linger beautifully*

### **Vinosa Essenza di Primitivo 2008 Puglia, Italy 29**

*there's a spicy peppery edge to freshen the ripe black cherry fruit with lasting flavors of blackberry and wildflower honey*

### **Line 39 Petite Sirah 2006, Lake County, California 30**

*aromas of dark fruit and strawberry with a hint of herbs that finishes with soft full tannins*

### **Ravenswood Zinfandel 2006, Napa Valley, California 30**

*a bold wine boasting of bright raspberry and plum fruits with hints of saffras, vanilla clove and cinnamon*

### **Substance Syrah 2008, Colombia Valley, Washington 30**

*flavors and aromatics of blackberry, black currant, raspberry plum, white pepper cinnamon, anise, oak chocolate, toast and violets*

### **La Posta Pizzella Malbec 2007, Mendoza, Argentina 33**

*a showy layer of mocha leads the way for spice cake, raspberry, and boysenberry fruit flavors laid over a lush creamy finish*

### **Mana NZ Pinot Noir 2007 Marlborough, New Zealand 36**

*a seductive and elegant wine with pronounced red berry fruits and a lingering spicy oak character*

### **Cinnabar Merlot 2006, Paso Robles 38**

*easy tannins and low acids frame ripe cherry liqueur and blackberry jam flavors with rich leathery earthiness*

### **St. Francis "Old Vines" Zinfandel 2006, Sonoma Valley 40**

*earthy aromas lead to flavors of cherry and leather with a long spicy finish*

### **Dutch Bill Creek Pinot Noir 2006, Sonoma Coast 41**

*layer of black cherry, ripe plum and briar jam flavors laced with a hint of spice and toffee in soft oak*

### **Alta Ridge "25 Brix" Merlot 2004, Bennett Valley 43**

*a big wine with dark fruit and leather on the nose leading to flavors of black cherry, tobacco and pepper*

### **Tolaini Al Passo Toscana IGT 2005, Italy 50**

*Spicy notes of French oak rise above lovely aromas and flavors of cherry and berry*

### **Huia Pinot Noir 2006, Marlborough, New Zealand 53**

*intense bouquet of dark cherry, blackberry and violets meld with hints of smoke and savory spicy notes on the palate with well integrated silky tannins*

### **Pelligrini "Cloverdale Ranch" Cabernet Sauvignon 2005**

#### **Alexander Valley, California 55**

*ripe cherry and black currant aromas dominate the nose with chocolate, coffee and spice notes adding complexity*

### **Robert Keenan Merlot 2004, Napa Valley 67**

*a dense, rich and concentrated wine with moderate tannins that are sweet and well integrated with the flavors of black cherries, currants, roasted espresso and earth notes*

### **Smith Madrone Cabernet Sauvignon 2003, Napa Valley 75**

*deep ruby-black red color with aromas of black cherry, crushed violets, lavender and dark chocolate it is big, smooth and has a velvety mouthfeel on the palate*

### **Beaux Freres Pinot Noir 2006, Willamette Valley, Oregon 97**

*plum currant and earthy mineral aromas and flavors linger against a burr of tannins*

### **Stags Leap "Artemis" Cabernet Sauvignon 2006, Napa Valley 100**

*a full bodied wine with aromas and flavors of black fruit, nutmeg, rosemary, grilled game and warm pie crust*

### **Girard "Pritchard Mountain" Cabernet Sauvignon 2005**

#### **Napa Valley 116**

*aromas of cassis, blackberries, winter spices and baker's cocoa with well integrated tannins and a nice balance of acidity and fruit*

## Whites

**Rudolf Muller "Bunny" Dry Riesling 2007**

**Pflaz, Germany 20**

*clean with refreshing fruit and solid acidity*

**Due Torri Pinot Grigio 2007, Italy 21**

*fresh and fruity with excellent balance*

**Fat Bastard Sauvignon Blanc 2007, France 25**

*on the palate this wine is crisp fresh and vivid*

**Fleur de California Chardonnay 2007, California 28**

*crisp, smooth and a brilliant color that sets the stage for aromas of apricots, lemon curd, honeysuckle, and pear*

**Crossroads Chardonnay 2006**

**Hawkes Bay, New Zealand 30**

*flavors of ripe stone fruit are combined seamlessly with nutty, toasty barrel characters a natural acidity supports the rich concentrated fruit*

**Crossroads Sauvignon Blanc 2007**

**Marlborough, New Zealand 30**

*delightful grapefruit give this wine a wonderful mouth watering character that leads to rich tropical fruit notes*

**Thomas Fogarty Gewurtraminer 2006 Monterey 32**

*distinctive asian spiciness along with the nuances of rose petals, water chestnuts, pineapples and sweet green peas*

**Leitz Dragonstone Riesling 2008, Rheingau, Germany 34**

*a frisky, bright and dynamic wine with smells of cherry cider, orange peels and mulling spices and flavors apple, cherry, and citrus with a wonderful sweet finish*

**Cinnabar Chardonnay 2007, Monterey 35**

*aromas of tropical fruit and honey with flavors of ripe mango, citrus, toasted oak and minerals*

**Huia Sauvignon Blanc 2007**

**Marlborough, New Zealand 36**

*white grapefruit flavors that come across as brisk and refreshing; a drier and more mineral style than many sauvignon blancs*

**Willakenzie Pinot Gris 2007 Willamette Valley, Oregon 38**

*a bright and juicy white with flavors of pineapple and melon that lead to a long and vivid finish*

**Willakenzie Pinot Blanc 2007, Willamette Valley, Oregon 40**

*a lively blend of pineapple, papaya, honeydew melon, orange blossoms and honeysuckle the nose and palate with a mineral note on the finish*

**Dr Loosen Brenkastler Kabinett Riesling 2007**

**Mosel, Germany 48**

*pineapple and apple flavors with hints of honey, a bit of unreleased CO2 adds raciness to the crisp refreshing finish*

**Cakebread Sauvignon Blanc 2007, Napa Valley 50**

*aromas of kiwi grapefruit and green melon hay and minerals lead to flavors of zesty citrus and melon that culminate in a refreshingly flinty, mineral-tinged finish*

**Smith Madrone Chardonnay 2006, Napa Valley 52**

*wonderful aromas of freshly-slice apples, with perfect acidity levels a soft middle and a fruity crispiness at the end this wine is exceptionally balanced*

**Chalk Hill Chardonnay 2006, Russian River Valley 75**

*aromas of white flower, sweet cream, ripe peach, lemon oil and wet stone lead to a palate with rich minerality with pear, pineapple, oranges, honeyed toast and brown spice*
